

Supports unusually creative early career investigators proposing innovative, high-impact research

- Started in 2007
- Early Stage Investigator (no NIH R01 or equivalent grant and within 10 years of doctoral degree or clinical training)
- Commit 25% research effort
- No preliminary data required
- Awards of \$1.5 million disbursed in first year of 5 year project period

Application – DP2

Research Strategy Essay	 10 pages: Scientific problem, significance, and potential impact Innovativeness of approach How risks and challenges will be addressed Suitability for award Investigator's qualifications
Budget, Animal, Human Subject Information	No detailed budget, other information brief
Letters of Collaboration	Not allowed
Research Effort	At least 25%
Letters of Reference	Not allowed



New Innovator Award Review Process







Peer-Review Process – Pre-Stage 1

- All applications are assigned to one panel (Integrated Review Group) – Musculoskeletal, Oral, and Skin Sciences IRG
- > Administrative Review: Check for completeness and ESI eligibility
- Applications are grouped based on science areas identified by applicant
- > Enter conflicts from application: Institutional / Collaborative
- > Recruit mail reviewers to cover all major science areas





Peer-Review Process: Stage 1 (Mail Reviews)

Panel of Mail Reviewers

Match reviewers with science in the application

3 Reviewers / Application

Three Criteria and an Overall Impact Score (1-9)

- ✓ "Importance and Potential Impact of the Scientific Problem"
- "Novelty / Innovativeness of Approach"
- ✓ "Creative Potential of ESI"
- > Overall Impact Paragraph





Stage 2: Selection of Finalists

- ✓ Rank order the Mail reviewers' Overall Impact Scores
- An unbiased selection of applications by the editorial panelists from the applications (based on overall impact scores and the critiques)
- ✓ About 20% of applications selected for Stage 2







Stage 2: Editorial Review

- 26-27 panelists who are senior members and experts with broad scientific understanding
 - Each application assigned to 3 discussants and all applications are discussed
- Scoring is focused on Impact & Innovation
- Provide impact statement and impact score
- Release of Final scores and Summary statements
- Discussed statements: 2nd stage impact statements with resume and summary of discussion
- > Non-discussed statements: 1st stage critiques

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

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

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
